## Newberg, Oregon

The name Newberg may not ring any bells, but the town is the perfect gateway to Oregon's idyllic <u>Willamette Valley</u>, home to some of the country's best vineyards. Far more under-the-radar than Napa and Sonoma, the area is known for the fantastic Pinot Noirs it produces.
